In 2011, the institution made bold changes that were met with enthusiastic and wholehearted support. After making a major change in the institution's name, attendance increased 10% in the last fiscal year, membership revenue was up 25%, and our summer camps were 93% full within the first week of registration. A NEW NAME

In 2011, we made an exciting and invigorating change: we got a new name. Over the last few years, we've made a number of significant changes. We've developed new programs, opened three new exhibitions, brought in new animals, and de-installed our 30-year-old exhibition, "The Place Called San Mateo." These changes have helped us clarify who we are and what we do — *we bring children and families up close with the natural world.* The name "Coyote Point Museum" no longer reflected the exciting changes we had made and was associated with a struggling institution. On January 15, 2011, the institution officially changed its name to CuriOdyssey. The new name reflects the positive direction of the organization and the changes we have already made in our ongoing effort towards revitalization.

RECOGNITION

CuriOdyssey was recognized with multiple awards this past year. In May 2011, CuriOdyssey was awarded a *Make* magazine Education Award at the San Francisco Bay Area Maker Faire — a DIY festival of science, innovation, and creativity. For the third year in a row, CuriOdyssey was recognized by *Bay Area Parent* magazine as a Family Favorite. Finally, the institution was awarded the Nickelodeon Parents Connect "Parents' Pick Award" for Best Museum in the San Francisco metro area.



NEW ANIMALS

This year, CuriOdyssey welcomed new members to its animal family. In the Spring, we added a baby Red Fox to our Animal Ambassadors program. Our Animal Ambassadors are instrumental in programming that helps educate schools, groups, and visitors. Our zoo keepers have been working hard to train her so she can be included in future presentations and public programming. Also, during the summer we received two Cattle Egrets, a California Red-Sided Garter Snake, San Diego Mountain Kingsnakes, and Band-tailed Pigeons.

NEW EXHIBITION OPENS

In June, the institution opened its third exhibition, *Backyard Science*. The ten outdoor exhibits allow families to move beyond the walls of a science lab to investigate scientific phenomena in their own backyards. These exhibits join CuriOdyssey's two other standing exhibitions, *The Science of Nature* and *Tinkering*.

NATIONAL CREDIBILITY

CuriOdyssey continues to be recognized as a thought leader in informal science education. In March 2011, CuriOdyssey staff members presented on the subject of preschool and elementary science education at the 2011 National Science Teachers Association conference in San Francisco.

In addition, the Association of Zoos & Aquariums (AZA) granted accreditation to CuriOdyssey. While the institution has been accredited for the previous 10 years, institutions must successfully complete this rigorous accreditation process every five years. For the third time since the inception of our Wildlife Habitats, CuriOdyssey underwent a thorough investigation by AZA officials to ensure that we have and will continue to meet the AZA's ever-rising standards for animal care, veterinary programs, conservation, education, safety, and visitor service.

Lastly, CuriOdyssey zoo keepers were awarded the American Association of Zoo Keepers (AAZK) Certificate of Merit for Zoo Keeper Education. This award is given to organizations that actively work to promote educational programs and recognizes CuriOdyssey's longtime commitment to providing opportunities such as its zoo keeper apprenticeship program, a six-month adult volunteer internship, and a keeper-in-training program. In addition, CuriOdyssey zoo keeper, Jennifer Gale, was recognized with the AAZK's Lee Houts Excellence in Enrichment Award, for the exceptional work she has done developing a comprehensive animal enrichment program at CuriOdyssey.

But moments after receiving the award, Mariko gave her five dollars to a teammate who felt terrible about an error she made during the game. Mariko told her she deserved the five dollars because she really did try to do her best even though she made a mistake.

I could not have been more proud of Mariko for her demonstration of teamwork, selflessness, compassion, and maturity. She attributed her ability to give up something she worked so hard to earn because of what she learned about teamwork and leadership as a camp Leader-in-Training.

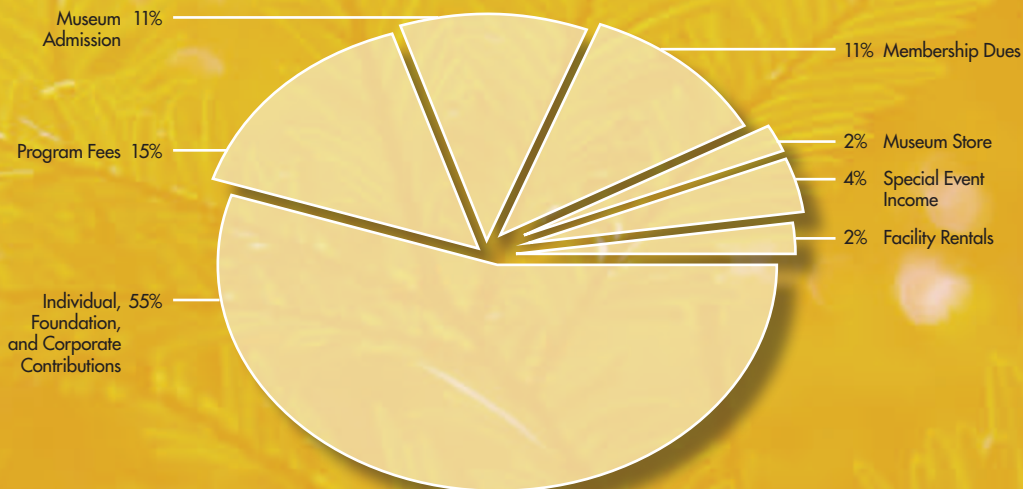

Financial Review 2010-2011

CuriOdyssey saw a substantial increase in both earned revenues and contributed revenues compared to the prior fiscal year. The numbers presented here do not include non-cash adjustments (in-kind donations, depreciation, etc.)

FY 2011 REVENUES



Total revenues were \$1,896,336, of which \$1,050,407 came from Individual, Foundation, and Corporate Contributions, \$274,026 from Program Fees, \$201,908 from Museum Admission, \$207,884 from Membership Dues, \$42,786 from Museum Store (net cost of goods sold) \$83,098 from Special Event Income (net of event expenses) and \$36,227 from Facility Rental Income.

FY 2011 PROGRAMS AND SERVICE EXPENSES



Total expenditures were \$2,458,931, of which \$1,851,168 (75%) were utilized for Programs, \$292,803 (12%) for Administration, \$314,960 (13%) for Fundraising & Membership.

Of the Program expenditures, \$526,552 was for Wildlife Care, \$217,380 for School Services & Volunteers, \$481,127 for Public Programs & Exhibits, \$275,595 for Buildings and Grounds, \$298,602 for Outreach, and \$51,912 for the Museum Store.
