X2 Amount of Average Gift






The average gift amount doubled compared to the previous year.

Our donors tripled the total amount raised from the year before.


Number of Donors

New Garden Aviary

Have you seen our newest garden aviary? This aviary houses Trudy, our Western screech owl. Trudy was born with a congenital birth defect which caused her to have minimal eyesight and eventually led to the removal of her right eye. She came to us from a wildlife rehabilitation center in October 2008, where she was dropped off as a fledgling.



Western screech owls are skilled hunters; they are known to stalk and ambush their prey. Impaired eyesight makes hunting and escaping predators a very difficult task. Because of this, Trudy was deemed non-releasable by the wildlife rehabilitation center, and she came to live with us at CuriOdyssey shortly thereafter.

Trudy has been an Animal Ambassador for many years but she recently retired from programs. You can see her perched in her exhibit from now on, listening to the comings and goings of visitors. Come visit her soon!
