## My mornings at Camp CuriOdyssey

- When we get there, they will sign me in at a table and I will put my stuff on a hook or in a cubby.
- There are always activities out for me to do right away, so I say "see you later" to mom or dad and get to work!
  - I will play until all the other kids are checked in and it is 9:00 am!



#### Welcome circle!

- Every morning after everyone is checked in by 9:00 am, we make a big welcome circle.
  - The first day of camp we go over rules for camp that help keep me safe!
  - Everyday at circle time we go over the schedule for the day. It has pictures so that I can follow a little easier.
    - We can look at it whenever we want to know what happens next!

 Sometimes sitting and listening for a long time is hard, so the teachers give us brain breaks.

## Activity time!

- After circle time comes activity time!
  - Activity time is different for every camp, but they all have one thing in common...FUN!
  - · Activities have to do with the theme of the camp you are in.
    - For example: activity time in Gadgets and Gizmos may mean that we are making something.
  - At Camp CuriOdyssey I am given space to explore, discover, and create on my own and at my own pace.
    - Its important to listen to camp staff during activity time because they are there to help me learn and keep me safe.







#### **Break time!**

- Sometimes, my brain needs a break from all of the working.
- We can take breaks whenever we need them on our own, all I have to do is ask!
- We also take breaks as a group to eat snack, go to the bathroom,

go on walks or get the wiggles out.

• Breaks help my brain get ready to learn again!

#### Lunch time!

• Every camp has an area where we eat lunch. Sometimes, it's even with other camps so I have the chance to make even more friends!

 A very important safety guideline is that we should only eat our own food during lunch time. We don't want anyone to get sick!

and eat while chatting with a friend.



#### More activities!
