In the middle of the day, we will eat lunch.

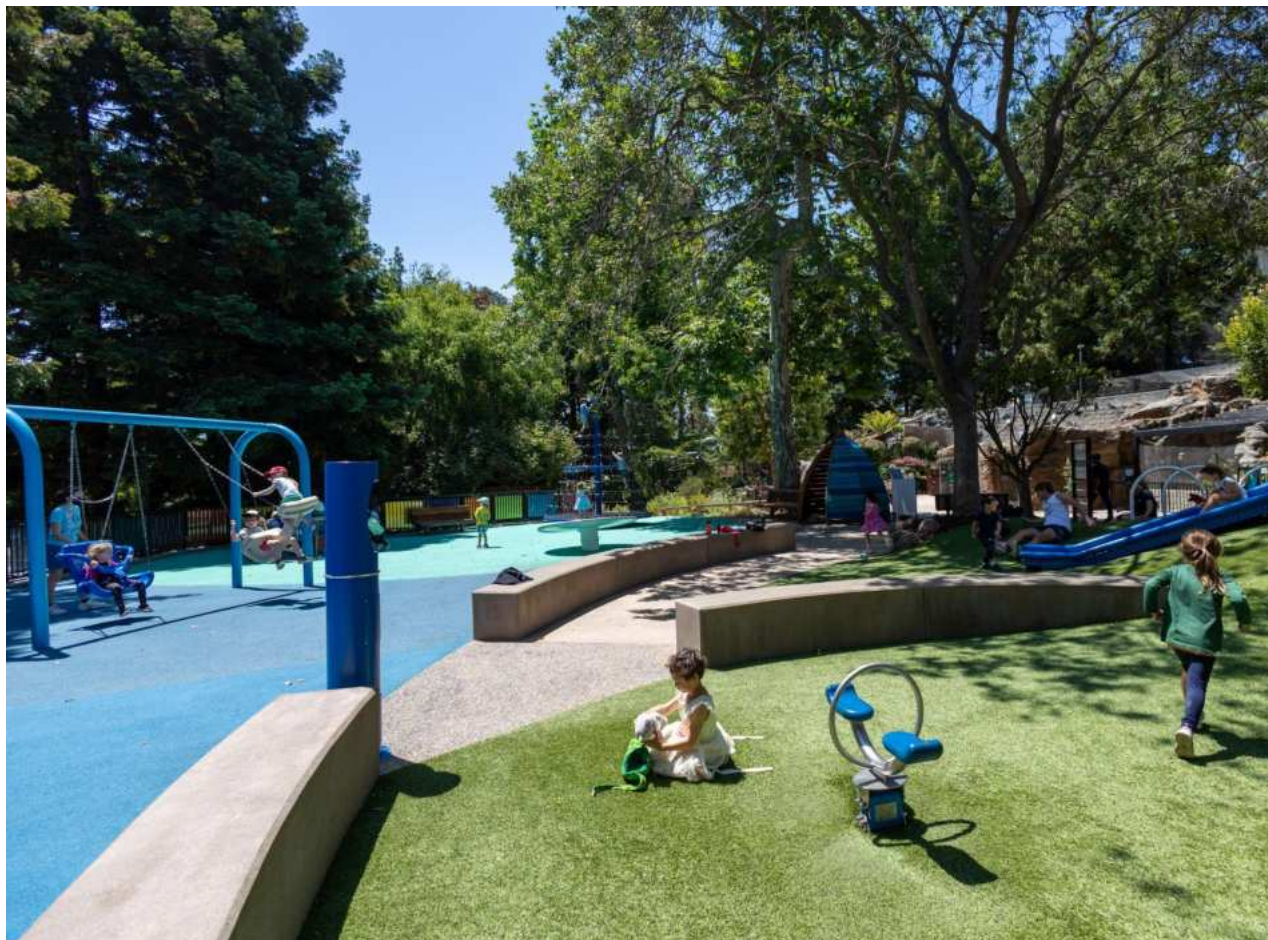
If I'm hungry I can ask my teachers if I can eat a snack from my bag.
